Itinerary

DAY 1 - MON, MAR 15: NORTH AMERICA | VENICE, ITALY

Tour members gather at the departure gate at the airport three hours prior to our departure to Italy. Dinner and breakfast are served in-flight.

DAY 2 TUE, MAR 16: VENICE

Upon arrival at Venice airport, we will be met by our Tour Escort and transferred to our hotel. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 3 WED, MAR 17: VENICE (MESTRE) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. After a good breakfast, we will transfer to the Tronchetto to catch the Vaporetto boat to Venice Island (ticket included).

Upon arrival, we will have a half day tour of Venice (with local guide), including St. Mark's Cathedral, Doges Palace and the Academy of Fine Arts (all external visits). Time at leisure in the afternoon for an optional gondola ride (not included). Back to Mestre for dinner and overnight in the hotel.



DAY 4 THU, MAR 18: VENICE (MESTRE) | PISA | FLORENCE

(330KM+90KM) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Today we travel to Florence, crossing the serene Tuscan countryside. Along the way, we will stop in Pisa, to see on our own the famous Leaning Tower of Pisa, the Duomo (Cathedral) and the Baptistery at the Piazza dei Miracoli. We then arrive in Florence, the city considered to be the cultural heart of Italy and former stronghold of the Medici family. Dinner and overnight in the hotel.

DAY 5 FRI, MAR 19 FLORENCE

After Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Today we begin our beautiful trip by visiting (with local guide) the Piazza della Signoria, where Neptune Fountain stands. Then, we visit the Baptistery with its "Gates of Paradise" doors (external visit) and the Accademia that houses Michelangelo's original statue of David (entrance included). We will also see (with local guide) the Santa Croce Church (entrance included), that is the famous Church where Michelangelo and many others are buried. Dinner and overnight in the hotel.

DAY 6 SAT, MAR 20: FLORENCE - ASSISI- ROME

(175KM+175KM) Buffet breakfast in the hotel. This morning we drive through the Autostrada del Sole, across the Roman countryside, towards Rome. Along the way, we stop for a visit (with local guide) in Assisi, seeing St. Francis' and St. Claire's Basilicas. If time permits, short stop on your own at the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels. On to Rome. Dinner and overnight in the hotel.



DAY 7 SUN, MAR 21: ROME

Buffet breakfast in the hotel. After breakfast, we tour (with local guide) Ancient Rome highlights, including the Appian Way, Palatine Hill, the Roman Forum, Arch of Constantine, Circus Maximus (all external visits) and the Catacombs of St. Callixtus (entrance included). This afternoon is at leisure for activities on your own. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 8 MON, MAR 22: ROME

Buffet breakfast in the hotel. After breakfast, we visit (with local guide) St. Peter's square and Basilica. We will have the possibility also to visit the Vatican Museums, with the Gallery, Raphael's rooms and the Sistine Chapel (entrance included). This afternoon is at leisure to see the Trevi Fountain, the Spanish Steps or activities on your own. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

DAY 9 TUE, MAR 23: ROME / DEPARTURE

Buffet breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to Rome FCO airport for departure from Rome to the United States: the end of a most enjoyable journey
